

PASTRY SPECIALIST

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The training pathway delivers a high-level technical specialization to 20 young people coming from vocational training or technical education pathways who possess a solid prerequisite knowledge and skills base in pastry-making. Starting with an alignment module, the course covers all topics related to the management of a pastry business. It explores in depth both innovative and traditional raw materials and production techniques, with specific attention to sustainability and to the particular preferences and needs of the consumer/client. The teaching approach is experiential, delivered by instructors from the professional world, with real-life assignments and educational visits.

TARGET PARTICIPANTS

Young people, resident or domiciled in Lombardy, holding one of the following qualifications:

- Upper secondary school diploma
- Professional diploma (IeFP technician)
- Level III European qualification certificate obtained in IeFP pathways prior to the 2009/2010 training year
- Admission to the fifth year of a liceo pathway
- Or, in the absence of an upper secondary school diploma, following the accreditation of coherent competences acquired in previous education, training or work pathways after fulfilment of compulsory education obligations. For Italian and foreign citizens who obtained a qualification abroad, the provisions of Directorate-General for Education, Training and Labour Circular Prot. E1.0539654 of 24/06/2010 "Determinations regarding access requirements for post-compulsory training pathways leading to Lombardy Region certificates" apply.

JOB OUTCOMES

Artisan high-end pastry shops, industrial laboratories, 4-5 star hotels, fine-dining restaurants, confectionery production companies.

DURATION AND VENUE

The pathway consists of 500 hours of classroom and laboratory training that simulates real working conditions in the sector, plus 500 hours of internship. Company internships and educational visits are included.

PARTICIPATION PROCEDURE

Access to the course is subject to a selection test and an interview. Students holding a 4th-year IeFP diploma in a coherent address will take only the interview.

ENROLMENT FEE

The course is free of charge.
