

WATCHMAKING TECHNICIAN

TRAINING PATH DESCRIPTION – The Watchmaking Technician course aims to provide students with comprehensive preparation in the practical activity of the watchmaker. The training values both the heritage of artisanal traditions and contemporary technological innovation. The curriculum therefore integrates traditional watchmaking methods with the most advanced diagnostic techniques, carried out using state-of-the-art electronic instrumentation.

TRAINING MODULES: Watchmaking laboratory, Applied computer science, Marketing and communication, Sector-specific micro-language English and French, Safety.

TARGET PARTICIPANTS – The course is aimed at a maximum of 20 residents or domiciled individuals in Lombardy, holding one of the following qualifications: upper secondary school diploma or professional diploma obtained following four-year leFP pathways and IFTS Certification, in accordance with Law No. 107/2015 and in compliance with the guidelines approved by the State-Regions Agreement of 20/01/2016.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES – Through this pathway, it will be possible to enter repair ateliers of manufacturing brands, repair laboratories and service centres, independent watchmaking workshops.

COURSE DURATION AND LOCATION – The course lasts two years, for a total of 1,800 hours, of which 636 hours are company internships. Company internship activities, educational visits, and full-immersion experiences are also included.

Course location: Viale Murillo, 17, Milan.

PARTICIPATION METHOD – Admission to the course is subject to a motivational and aptitude interview and a practical test aimed at assessing manual dexterity.

ENROLLMENT FEE – The intervention is co-financed with public resources and provides for an annual fee of 1,400 euros, for a total of 2,800 euros. After the start of the courses, some fee reductions based on ISEE will be made available through a call.

FINAL CERTIFICATION – Diploma of Specialization in Applied Technologies - EQF Level V. Graduates may request recognition of university credits (CFU) for degree programs at universities partnered with Innovaprofessionisti.
